ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

The Counseling Program in the College of Letters and Sciences at Arizona State University invites applications for a clinical assistant professor position. The assistant professorship requires teaching in the master’s program, advising master’s degree students, supervising clinical training in our state-of-the art Counselor Training Center, and participating in activities related to administration of the CACREP-accredited master’s program.

QUALIFICATIONS

REQUIRED

A doctorate in Counselor Education from a Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs accredited doctoral program at the time of appointment; evidence of teaching excellence and experience; and clinical supervision experience.

DESIRED

Ability to supervise in Spanish. Licensure-eligible as a Licensed Professional Counselor in Arizona.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

A complete application must be received by 5:00pm MST, November 30, 2015; if the position is not filled, applications will be reviewed every Friday thereafter until the search is closed. It is estimated the review of applications will begin on December 1, 2015 with continual review as needed until the search is closed.

A complete application must include: (1) a letter of interest outlining candidate qualification; (2) a curriculum vita; and (3) contact information for three professional references.
