Immaculata University's M.A. in Clinical Mental Health Counseling program is excited to expand our current faculty. We are a highly collaborative group of four who identify as counselor educators and are adding to our existing faculty. Our program has submitted our CACREP self-study and anticipates a site visit in the Spring of 2016. The IU Clinical Mental Health Counseling program is seeking a colleague to join us in our program as we move forward with CACREP accreditation. The position is for a full-time, tenure track academic year appointment which includes summer classes. The required teaching load is a total of 24 credits per year.

Successful candidates will have an earned doctorate in Counselor Education from a CACREP accredited program, a minimum of three years professional experience including teaching or academic experience. Eligibility for Pennsylvania licensure is required. The position includes teaching, advisement, dissertation mentoring and other departmental and university responsibilities. The preferred candidate will have experience teaching CACREP core courses. The position ideally would start in Spring 2016. Immaculata University is an EOE.
