Position Summary	<p>The College of Education invites applications for a full-time (1.00 FTE), 12-month fixed-term Instructor position. Reappointment is at the discretion of the Dean.</p> <p>The primary purpose of this position is to provide instruction and advising for our Master of Counseling (MCoun) Program. This program is delivered through a hybrid format. The instructional delivery modalities are: (1) synchronous online, (2) in-class, and (3) asynchronous online. For each class, the approximate time ratio of the modalities is as follows: 42.50: 42.50: 15.00 (SO: IC : AO).</p> <p>The College of Education contributes to major national dialogues concerning research and the promotion of social justice in (1) the success of English language learners elementary through college; (2) instruction elementary through college; (3) learning in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics inside and outside of school; (4) mental health and school counseling (5) higher education leadership; and (6) adult learning. Serve continuously as a committee member on six (6) student committees in the PhD program.</p>
