The Department of Counseling and Human Development is seeking candidates for two full time, nine month, tenure track Assistant Professor positions. SDSU is especially interested in candidates that can contribute to and/or coordinate course offerings that address the experiences of underrepresented minorities in organizations. RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Teach a variety of graduate courses in a CACREP-approved master's level program.
- Provide service on departmental committees and to the community.
- Conduct research and scholarship.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Earned doctorate in the area of Counselor Education by August 2016; or an equivalent doctorate plus one year full-time teaching in a CACREP accredited counseling program prior to the 2012-2013 school year.
- Must be eligible for licensure and/or certification.
- Demonstrated ability to teach core counseling courses.
- Demonstrated ability to teach in a graduate program including clinical supervision courses.
- Effective interpersonal, verbal, and written communication skills.
- The ability/willingness to work collaboratively.
- Strong record of scholarly productivity.
- Commitment to equality and diversity.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Evidence or strong interest in working with minority groups.
- Experience/expertise in a specific area of interest (i.e. marriage, couple and family counseling, student affairs, first generation college students, etc.).

- Demonstrated ability and interest in teaching through classroom, online, and hybrid methods.
- Demonstrated evidence of scholarly productivity.
