The University of Saint Joseph is seeking a full-time assistant professor to fill a position in its CACREP accredited Clinical Mental Health Counseling program. This position will begin during the month of August 2016. The successful candidate will have academic, as well as clinical experience specific to the CMHC position, possess a strong work ethic, and have the ability to engage others in a professionally caring manner. Clinical experience working with families will be viewed favorably but not required.

Responsibilities include teaching, scholarly publication in the field of counseling, advising students, assisting with the coordination of practicum and internship placements, and participating in service at the department, school, and institutional levels.

Qualifications include completion of an earned doctoral degree (ABD considered) in Counselor Education preferably from a CACREP accredited program, clinical and teaching experience germane to the position, and a commitment to an outcome and ethics-based curriculum designed to prepare students for competent counseling practice.
