Position Title: Open Rank Search in School Counseling

The interdisciplinary Department of Human and Organizational Development (HOD) is seeking applicants for a *practice/clinical or tenure-stream* faculty member in school counseling. Preference will be given to assistant professors, but more senior appointments in either line are possible for exceptional candidates. Candidates must have a doctorate in school counseling, clinical mental health counseling, or a closely related discipline. Preference will be given to candidates who graduated from or are eligible to teach in a CACREP-accredited counseling program. Candidates for a tenure-track position will have a productive research program with a track record of (or potential for) external funding. Candidates for a practice or clinical position will have a record of scholarship related to counseling or counselor education, and interest or experience in advising and supervising counseling interns. All candidates should have excellent teaching credentials, a focus on preparing school counselors for culturally diverse settings, and the ability to contribute to the department's undergraduate, graduate, and professional programs. Candidates with interests in positive youth development, social and emotional learning, college access and completion for underrepresented groups, or the intersection of schools and health are especially encouraged to apply. This faculty position provides a unique opportunity to join a highly productive, diverse, and interdisciplinary faculty. Review of applications will begin November 15, 2015.
