Maintain active scholarship agenda and research plan. Maintain licenses and certifications appropriate to areas of clinical practice. Provide service to the university and to the profession of counseling.

At least 3-5 years of licensed clinical practice experience in community mental health settings. Graduate teaching experience preferred.
